You will now have a code that is specific to your property. This code is for your personal use. Please be sure to have your guests call your name for access. Please take the time to fill out the gate access form and return it to make sure we have your name and correct contact number at the front gate for your guests to call you for access. If you forget your private code, call your lot number from the gate and let yourself in the gate by pressing 9 when you answer.

NOTE: Front gate call box: The resident will get a call from 972-231-1999 which is a Texas number. It is a good idea to give the 972-231-1999 number a contact name on each person's contact list, such as "Horseshoe Acres gate", so there will be no confusion. When you receive a call from the front gate you will be asked to press 1 to receive call. By resident pressing 9 on the phone, it will open the gates and raise the bars to allow access. In some cases, the resident may be an Administrator of the residence with a smart phone. In that case, the resident will be able to see a picture of the person requesting entrance and can push the open button on the smart phone.
